



Rain-Out Procedures

- 1.) Call the Denver Parks and Recreation Hotline (303) 458-4801 **after 4 pm on the day of the game.** If the Hotline recording states that the field that you are scheduled to play on is not playable, then the game is canceled and you will need to reschedule using the guidelines listed below.
- 2.) If the Hotline recording states that the field you are scheduled to play on is playable, then the game is not canceled, and both teams and the umpire should report to the field as scheduled.
- 3.) If you arrive at the field and field conditions are questionable, then the two head coaches and the umpire will decide if the game will be played. If a unanimous decision cannot be reached between the two head coaches and the umpire then a vote will be taken. The umpire, and both head coaches will receive one vote each. The majority (two out of three) will decide the issue of whether or not the game is to be played as scheduled. If the game is canceled you will need to reschedule the game using the guidelines listed below.

Rescheduling Guidelines

- 1.) Coaches match up their schedules and find a couple of days that they are able to play the makeup game.
- 2.) Home coach reviews the Master Schedule from the website and finds a couple of open fields.
- 3.) Home coach contacts the league scheduler and reserves the open field for the makeup game. Fields are reserved on a first come, first served basis. Please do not schedule a makeup game without reserving the field first. Once the field has been officially reserved the opposing coach is notified of the time and location of the makeup game.
- 4.) The league scheduler advises the league umpire assignor to assign umpires for the makeup game. Note – games scheduled on short notice are difficult to cover with umpires, and it is not a certainty that an umpire will be available for the makeup game.
- 5.) Each coach notifies their respective director of the details of the makeup game.

The Master Schedule will be updated as fields for makeup games are reserved. Please make sure you have a current copy of the Master Schedule when you are scheduling your makeup game.
